## Project impact

- All **four VET project partners** signed a legal document to adopt and recognize the MeMeVET Curriculum within their own organizations
- **30 Agreements with VET providers and stakeholders** in the five participating countries to adopt the unique European Curriculum to foster mobility in Europe
- Spanish and Bulgarian certification agencies for VET are discussing the adoption of the MeMeVET modules
